1. Chairman Mislowsky called the meeting to order.
2. Approval of the July 15, 2010 minutes. The minutes were approved.
3. Staff Report:

Martha Shickle spoke to the committee about the CDBG money assigned to Habitat for Humanity. Cheryl Connolly and her staff are in the researching stage of acquiring 319 & 321 S. Kent Street property. Plans are to demolish property and redevelop with a side by side duplex home. The Committee approved the intentions of use of the CDBG funds for this project.

The Fairfax-Diehl-Kent Street Revitalization plan was approved by Council. John Hill stated that there will be more follow up for input from the neighborhood to see exactly what the project will entail.

The Douglas Learning Center sub-committee has disbanded. Plans are for the DCLC to use the school during John Kerr renovations. There was discussion regarding the \$70,000 that was allocated to the school that is now available. Committee agreed to publically advertise that the money is available and consider proposals of use at November meeting.
