Swim Lesson Registration Instructions

- Swimming lessons have a "Register On" date, so please be aware of which day you need to register.
 - Resident (R) registration is for people who live in the City of Winchester (22601 zip code). Non-resident (NR) registration is the following day (zip code other than 22601).
 - Registrations are taken by phone or onsite starting at 5:30 am. All classes are first-come, first-serve. If space is remaining, an additional registration day is the Friday before the start of class.
 - If classes are full, you can request to be added to the waiting list. We will do our best to accommodate additional children in the classes. You will be notified at least one day prior to the first day of class if we were able to fit your child in the session.
- Have the program's activity number ready. This can be found on the Aquatics pages of the guide.
- Payment is required at the time of registration. No registration will be processed without payment.

You will only be charged if your child is placed in a class. If your child does not get into the session, you will need to re-register for the next session. Students on the waiting list do not carry over to the next session.




