I, Kari J. Van Diest, Deputy Clerk of the Common Council, hereby certify on this 24th day of April, 2013, that the following Ordinance is a true and exact copy of one and the same adopted by the Common Council of the City of Winchester, assembled in regular session on the 9th day of April 2013.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION 14-66 OF THE WINCHESTER CITY CODE PERTAINING TO INSTALLATION; REQUIRED LEGEND AND SIGNALS

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Winchester, Virginia, has determined that it is necessary to provide flexibility of meter rates at a charge not to exceed seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per hour from Monday through Friday when meters are enforced.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that Section 14-66 of the Winchester City Code is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

SECTION 14-66. INSTALLATION; REQUIRED LEGEND AND SIGNALS.

(B) Each parking meter installed as provided in this section shall indicate, by proper legend, the legal parking time established by the City for the particular parking meter. Each such meter shall be set so as to display a signal showing legal parking upon the deposit of the appropriate coin or coins, lawful money of the United States, for the period of time prescribed, which parking meters shall require the deposit of coin(s) of the denominations of nickels, dimes or quarters permitting parking at a charge ~~not to exceed twenty-five cents (\$0.25) per one half hour~~ not to exceed seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per hour. Each such meter shall be so arranged that, upon the expiration of the lawful time limit, it will indicated by a proper visible signal that the lawful parking period has expired.
