## IN BLUE RECYCLE BIN

**YES**

- Glass bottles & jars
- Aluminum cans & foil
- Steel & tin cans
- All Plastics (except Styrofoam)

**NO**

- Unrinsed bottles & cans
- Styrofoam
- Window glass
- Dishes & cookware
- Light bulbs
- Aerosol cans

## ATTENTION

### BOTTLES + CANS + PLASTICS

- Bottles, cans and plastics can be mixed together in the same container.
- Rinse all materials of excess contents.
- Place together in the blue recycling bin or reusable container under 45 gallons (such as a laundry basket or trash can).
- Do not mix with paper recycling materials.

### PAPER

- Put all paper in a separate container:
  1. reusable container under 45 gallons, such as a laundry basket or trash can
  2. paper bag (not plastic bags)
  3. cardboard box
- Do not mix the paper items with the bottles, cans and plastics.

NOTE: There is no limit on how many containers with recycling you can place curbside.

## IN PAPER BAGS

**YES**

- Newspapers & inserts
- Magazines & catalogs
- Office Paper
- Junk Mail
- Phonebooks
- Paperboard (cereal boxes, etc)
- Cardboard

**NO**

- Food-stained products
- Milk cartons
- Juice cartons & boxes
- Ice Cream cartons
- Wax-coated boxes
- Used paper towels or tissues
- Trash

## COLLECTION TIMES

Place all materials curbside no later than 7:30 AM on the day of collection, but not before 6:00 PM the night before.  
Please remove containers from the curb the same day.
