Street Tree Canopy Program

The “Right-Tree-Right-Place” Street Tree Canopy Program is aimed at creating a safe, healthy and attractive tree canopy through replacement of over-mature, declining trees that are in conflict with overhead electric lines.

The City will replace all trees removed with a two-inch caliper appropriate species for the location, however, there is no guarantee of replant if underground utilities or other obstructions are found during the removal process. A replant on private property may be an option.

Program Steps

-  Identification and assessment of current tree/electric line conflicts
-  Meet with property owner to discuss options for tree replacement
-  Remove target trees
-  Replant with the right tree in the right place

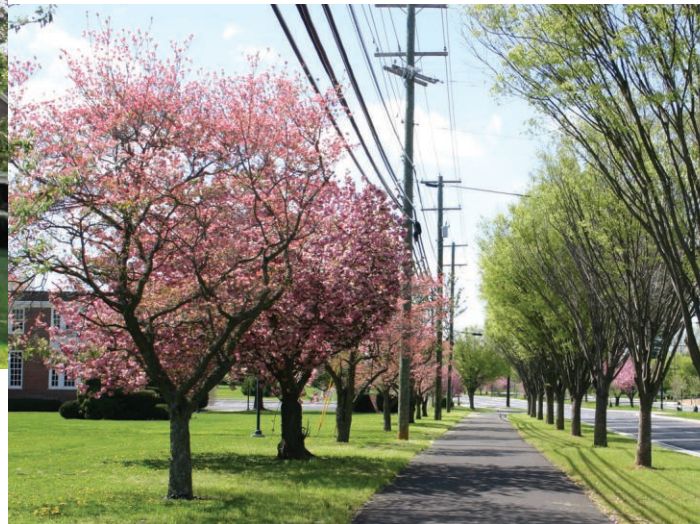
