



The demolition of the Winchester Towers building, located at 200 North Cameron Street, will begin on **Monday, October 31.**



**Temporary Traffic Pattern Changes Effective October 30:** For safety reasons, the travel lanes adjacent to the building will be temporarily modified. One lane of traffic in each direction on East Piccadilly and North Cameron will be maintained during the demolition.

This project will take approximately **12-15 weeks** to complete (weather permitting).

Please move all vehicles out of the parking lot behind 200 N. Cameron Street by Friday, October 28. Vehicles that are left in the construction zone will need to be towed at the owners expense to allow construction to begin.

We realize that this project may be an inconvenience for you and downtown traffic. To help reduce potential congestion in the area, traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep traffic moving as efficiently as possible. However, motorists who regularly travel through this intersection may want to consider an alternate route during the demolition process.


