Winchester Parks and Recreation afterschool program is called The HIVE (elementary school, Pre-K-4th grade) and HIVE Club (middle school, 5th-8th grades).

The HIVE and HIVE Club program offers a wide range of activities. We gear towards the recreation base afterschool programming, allowing the children to run off that extra spurt of energy they receive while in school! The program uses the Park's amenities, such as the playground, ball fields, open field space, disk golf course, racquetball court, and the gym. The HIVE and HIVE Club program is open from dismissal of school until 6:00pm. We do offer a No School Day program for when the school system has Teacher work days, spring/winter breaks, and snow days.

We participate with VDH (Virginia Department of Health) (Child and Adult Care Food Program), which allows us to bring healthier snacks options to the children involved in our program. This program is available to all that are enrolled in the afterschool program The HIVE and HIVE Club.

Our program was awarded 2016 Out-of-School Time grant from NPRA (National Park and Recreation Association) and Walmart Foundation. This grant will allow for us to replace some of our equipment, upgrade storage for our snack program and center bins, extra programming into our current program guide and much more!

Our staff provides a full day summer camp program during the summer, PB&J Club for toddlers, middle school dances and family special events.
