



## BUDGET

The accounts of the City are organized into funds. Of the City's adopted budget, most of the big spending decisions occur within the General Fund.

### General Fund

The fund where the City has the most discretion, the General Fund, has two major sources of funding: general property taxes and other local taxes combined. These two sources make up over 80% of the General Fund budget.

### Capital Improvement Plan

Every year, the City adopts a plan for capital improvements for the next five years. Capital Improvements are projects such as construction of roads and public buildings, traffic systems, park improvements, sewers, water infrastructure, etc.

### OpenGov Budget Tool

An online interactive budget transparency tool that allows users to explore the City's budget in real time. Updated monthly.

## EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Disasters happen anytime and anywhere. When disaster strikes, you may not have much time to respond. Be prepared for disaster before it occurs. [www.readyva.gov](http://www.readyva.gov).

### Get Emergency Alerts

Register to receive emergency alerts from the City of Winchester via text, email or phone (mobile or landline). Must enter a 22601 address. OPT-IN to receive non-emergency notices:

- Refuse/recycling schedule changes
- City facility closures
- Snow Plan activation

### Community Emergency Response Team (CERT)

When emergencies happen, CERT members can assist and support their community by applying techniques learned during CERT training.

### Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)

The EOP explains how the City will respond to and recover from disasters and emergency situations.

### Pet Sheltering


