

Access the Laurel Ridge Community College bus with a direct transfer from any WinTran route at the Boscawen Street Transfer Station or park and ride with stops located near all city parking garages, Handley High School, Shihadeh Innovation Center, and on Jubal Early Drive at Apple Blossom Drive.

Route will be departing downtown Winchester every 70 minutes, connecting you **to and from** the transfer station in downtown Winchester and Laurel Ridge Community College.

The last Laurel Ridge Community College bus departure will return to the transfer station or requested bus stop.

## **Hours of Operation**


The Laurel Ridge Route will run throughout the year except on designated holidays.

- All scheduled stop times are approximate. Please be at your designated stop 5 minute prior to schedule time.
