Water Meter & Sidewalk Replacement

The City will be replacing approximately 10,000 water meters, aging storm drains and surrounding sidewalks throughout the city over the next four years. This major project began in July and the first sidewalk work began on Fairmont Ave. Next area for sidewalk improvements: Cork (from Stewart to Academy), Academy, Shirley, Latane, Stonewall, Lee, and Joist Hite.

Kent & Woodstock Improvement Projects

Projects Begin in September 2018

The City will be replacing utility infrastructure (water mains, service lines and stormwater drains), repaving the street, and replacing sidewalks on North Kent Street between Millwood Avenue and Cork Street.

On Woodstock Lane from Pleasant Valley to Pine Street, the utility infrastructure will be replaced.

Road closures are expected and work will be conducted during off-peak hours in high-traffic areas. The contractor has 270 days to complete both projects. More information coming soon.
